



Know the Completion Criteria


- A. 20+ survey hours in a block over multiple visits.
- **B.** At least 80% of the species found in the block during the first Atlas are detected.
- **C.** At least 50% of the species detected are confirmed as breeding.
- **D**. All habitat types within block have been visited.
- E. Surveys were completed at different times of year.
- F. At least 2 night visits have occurred.

Suggested Calendar April: Nocturnal Visit (woodcock, owls)

 Early season, get familiar with block, contact landowners

May: migration confusing, but early nesters



Suggested Calendar

- June: Build your species list
- Visit later to S7
- Combine early morning or evening with a night
- Harder to confirm during June, but make sure species list complete



Suggested Calendar July – Singing drops off rapidly

- All about confirmations
- Repeated visits to different habitats
- Strategic visits for final confirmations



Suggested Calendar August – still productive first week, but migrants on the way

• Very targeted for final visits

It's over by mid-August except for:
Late breeders: American Goldfinch,
Cedar Waxwing
Long seasons: Rock Pigeon, Mourning
Dove, Northern Cardinal, Wild Turkey

Calendar Overview April/May: Study block, early breeders, beware migrants, first nocturnal visit

June: Build species list (2–4 visits), final nocturnal

July: Hit it hard (4–8 visits), work different habitats to rack up confirmations

August: Mop up, target final confirmations (2 final visits if needed)


